




with publications in specialized journals and online via e-mail campaigns and social media. In particular, participation in events is considered very important as most of the new memberships are negotiated during those events.



RESEARCH OFFICER'S WORD

One of the objectives we have used to define the activity of Research Officer in Latin America is to encourage the concept of "Education in Research". We know that this is extremely important to develop advances here and worldwide.

It has been a real pleasure to fulfill this major responsibility which is now in the home stretch. It was a real challenge and a great opportunity to meet colleagues interested in positioning the product of research in Latin America at the international level, since there has been an increase in publications by spine surgeons in high impact journals.

One of the activities proposed based on the TEAM principles, at the beginning of this administration, was to strengthen Education, with practical courses throughout Latin America, and also to elaborate teaching materials which would make it easier to acquire knowledge and allow understanding the entire methodological process, including learning to interpret the results to incorporate them into the medical surgical practice.

We are maintaining the concept of continuing education through the Online program, which has been improved and supported with new courses that will close the cycle of learning in Research.

These are the courses that are part of the new cycle of continuing education:


- 1. Online Course on Access to Information: Research in database.
- 2. Online Course on Research: Guidelines for interpreting the evidence.
- 3. Online Course on Research: Guidelines for writing a scientific paper.

On the other hand, the webinars have changed the process of education, since they have brought the terminology and concepts of methodology to the great majority of AOSpine members.

As part of the teaching material developed, the process of editing the second book on Education in Research has ended. Called "From Measurement to Interpretation-Surgical Biostatistics", it is comprised of 27 chapters. It makes it possible to understand and analyze simply and with common sense how to interpret each of the statistical tests and apply them to daily practice. Finally, I'd like to thank all members of AOSpine for their support and invite them to continue this important activity of producing research which will favor medical-surgical attention throughout Latin America.

Research is and will continue to be a very important pillar in assistential activities. It will allow analyzing our experience to improve our processes and render medical-surgical attention more efficient.

Points were assigned to each criterion and the total sum divided by the actual investment made in the region – the result is the final productivity score.

SPINE CENTERS AND FELLOWSHIPS OFFICER'S WORD

It has been an honour to be part of the Latin American board in this year. We kept going with the previous work developed by the past-officer Ratko Yurak, re-certificating training spine centres, and acknowledging ex-fellows.

We have updated and increased the information content received by the fellows at the beginning of their training with the 'Fellowship package'. Moreover, we reinforced the AOSpine brand inside the spine centres providing white coats identifying the centres, fellows, and centres directors.

In order to be more inclusive, as well as respond to some countries demands for more training centres and specific trainings, we expanded our certificated centres in the region. These includes:

- Clinica Alemana in Santiago, Chile
- Instituto Columna / Hospital Ortopédico Lifecenter in Belo Horizonte, Brazil
- Fundación Santa Fé in Bogotá, Colombia
- Hospital Pequeno Príncipe in Curitiba, Brazil
- Hospital Churruca Visca in Buenos Aires, Argentina

Focusing on a homogeneous fellowships distribution, we created the spine centres ranking to have an overall vision of our partners. It is based on the centre's participation inside AOSpine activities, scientific production, and compliance to the fellowship normative. It also includes a logbook, filled monthly by the fellows, giving us a realistic overview of the amount and kinds of surgeries provided by each centre.

Throughout this year, we have also included fellows and ex-fellows in local training programs as the Hospital Based Seminars, and we have set a MISS surgery workshop pilot for ex-fellows using a realistic spine model and high-tech equipment. For the next Advanced Level Live Tissue course in Curitiba, many ex-fellows AOSpine will be designated as faculties and tutors. In the Regional Course in Mexico we had the first ex-fellows meeting celebrating the 15 years of the program. Now we are already planning the second meeting for the Regional Course in

of the program. Now we are already planning the second meeting for the Regional Course in São Paulo, this time acknowledging personal experiences and the career development of young surgeons.

Finally, understanding the needs that some institutions have to have their own fellowships application processes – either for legal or administrative issues – we have developed the Associate Fellow category to offer the AOSpine benefits to the wider possible number of training surgeons.



clinical experience of the spine centers in 2017










CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM


The GSC continues to position itself as an event of the highest international relevance for the spine surgeon community. For four days, participants were able to enjoy a packed, outstanding

HOSPITAL BASED SEMINAR


We started the Hospital Based Seminars (HBS) Project in 2017. This is an initiative of AOSpine Latin America that was very well received by the international community and now is part of our Educational Plan.

The HBS are educational activities based on the AOSpine Curriculum and aimed at fellows, residents and medical staff of hospitals in the region. They are blended learning activity: there

is an online platform to facilitate integration between participants and Faculty and to provide complementary educational material before a face-to-face seminar.

Our goal is to propagate the AOSpine principles using a pre-established model event to present AOSpine to new surgeons and referral centers.





CADAVER AND LIVE TISSUE COURSES


Anatomical specimen courses are one of the highlights of our programs. This year we had four courses. All of them took place in Florida, USA. The topics discussed during the activities covered several pathologies such as tumor, deformities and MISS.

The live tissue courses are a great opportunity to obtain surgical skills. This year we had two courses: one took place in Curitiba and the other in Sao Paulo, both in Brazil. Topics discussed were interbody fusion and MIS decompression techniques.









HOSPITAL BASED SIMULATION TRAINING COURSE

The AOSpine simulation training in microsurgical decompression and interbody fusion is a hospital based course and took place in Curitiba (BR) in December 2nd. In this hospital-based course, participants trained microscopic decompression, interbody fusion and dural repair using simulators. The course included a mandatory online pre and post course assessment. It also included blended learning online pre-course activities that started one month prior to face-to-face practical training and consisted of self-directed learning complemented with virtual tutorial and case-based discussion.







THE FIRST SPINE CAMP

A collaboration of AOSpine Latin America and AOSpine North America, the first Spine Camp—MIS Personal Training Clinic was a unique opportunity to practice workflows and techniques using actual surgical tools in a highly realistic surgical simulation setting.

The training took place in Tampa, FL, (1) (US), last November 10-11, 2017. This was the first in a series of focused clinics to enhance skills in MIS surgery. It was designed for participants to master skills to perform MIS lumbar spine decompression and TLIF, showing how to deal with intraoperative CSF leaks, and on the discussion of clinical cases to facilitate the exchange of opinions between our excellent faculty group and the participants.

According to training educational advisor Néstor Taboada, g, the use of simulators will be part of future AOSpine courses. Fernando Nin (UY), one of the course participants, thanked the opportunity to participate and highlighted the quality of the course. "I want to thank and congratulate you for the course in Tampa. It was very good. The practical models seemed very real; the case discussion was very enriching; and the Faculty group was of a very high level and gave good contributions. I hope you can continue giving courses like this".




